| 3 | Information relating to the financial or business affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding that information). |
| 4 | Information relating to any consultations or negotiations, or contemplated consultations or negotiations, in connection with any labour relations matter arising between the authority or a Minister of the Crown and employees of, or office holders under, the authority. |
| 5 | Information in respect of which a claim to legal professional privilege could be maintained in legal proceedings. |
| 6 | Information which reveals that the authority proposes (a) to give under any enactment a notice under or by virtue of which requirements are imposed on a person; or (b) to make an order or direction under any enactment. |
| 7 | Information relating to any action taken or to be taken in connection with the prevention, investigation or prosecution of crime. |
