13	<b>Adult entertainment</b> Insertion of provisions related to adult entertainment.
13/14	<b>Early Morning Restriction Orders (EMRO) &amp; Late Night Levy (LNL)</b> Insertion of provisions related to Early Morning Restriction Orders and Late Night Levy, at this stage Tamworth Borough Council have not adopted these provisions. The situation will be kept under review.
14	<b>4. INTEGRATING OTHER REGULATORY CONTROLS</b> Licensing and Planning – clarification of roles and functions
16	<b>Noise and Other Public Nuisance</b> Change environmental health officer to Environmental Health Staff and authorised officer to reflect generalist role and or other staff being appropriately qualified to undertake work.
19	<b>5. INTEGRATING OTHER STRATEGIES</b> Live Music – no longer regulated entertainment and provisions explained, IN effect the sector has been deregulated to reduce burdens on business and promote creativity in the entertainment sector.
20	<b>Director of Public Health</b> Acknowledgement of role of Director of Public Health and role of health authority in Licensing. Work with partners e.g. Staffordshire and Stoke Responsible Body Group, Alcohol, Drugs, Executive Board etc are key to delivering improved health, business and community outcomes.
20	<b>Rebalancing Licensing</b> The rebalancing of Licensing initiative included new legislation and guidance. In effect it improved the means to tackle crime in disorder etc and the new provisions are described here. EMRO, LNL.
30	<b>12. PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM</b> Insertion of guidelines to assist committee dealing with reviews where underage sales have occurred.
33	<b>13. ENFORCEMENT</b> Better Regulation Delivery Office (BRDO) Acknowledgement of BDRO as a source of information for regulation.
