Counter Notice - Permitted Temporary Activities
 Section 105 Licensing Act 2003

Reference:

On **Insert Date TEN received** the licensing authority received from you, **Name of Premises User**, a temporary event notice ("the notice") in respect of proposed temporary licensable activities due to take place on **Insert dates of event** at **Premises Name & Address**. The licensing authority is satisfied that if the activities were to take place the crime and disorder licensing objective would be undermined.

A copy of this counter notice will be sent to the chief officer of police and the local authority exercising Environmental Health functions for the area in which the premises specified in the temporary event notice you gave is situated.

Under section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003 a person commits an offence if he carries on a licensable activity on or from any premises otherwise than under and in accordance with an authorisation; or if he knowingly allows a licensable activity to be so carried on. A person convicted of such an offence is liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding £20,000, or to both.

If this counter notice has been served on you, you may appeal against this decision. Any such appeal must be made to the Magistrates' court within 21 days beginning with the day on which you were notified by the licensing authority of the decision appealed against.

No appeal may be brought later than five working days before the day on which the event period specified in the temporary event notice begins.
