#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

At the Corporate Scrutiny Committee meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2019, it was approved that a working group be established to review the content and format of the Quarterly Performance report (minute 10 refers).

At the Corporate Scrutiny Committee meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> July 2019, the Chair reported that the working group looking at the QPR Report had met and considered the potential content for an executive summary to the QPR Reports for the Committee, which it was recommended should include data from the previous 8 quarters such that trends could be identified. It was noted that the executive summary was intended to be in addition to the detailed report provided.

It was reported that further work and engagement with Officers would be undertaken by the working group before a formal report was brought back to this Committee (minute 16 refers).

Following a meeting on 16<sup>th</sup> July 2019 with the Chair, Officers have prepared a draft executive summary dashboard for review / confirmation. An update was provided by the Chair at the meeting held on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2019 and it was agreed that the QPR Executive Summary working group outputs would be reported back to the Committee in February 2020 and then the Committee would consider whether to make any recommendations to Cabinet (minute 50 refers).

The proposed executive summary dashboard is attached at **Appendix 1** – for Members' review and confirmation. Should this be considered acceptable, the Chair of the Committee will request that Cabinet consider the changes for implementation in Quarterly Performance reporting from Quarter 4, 2019/20.

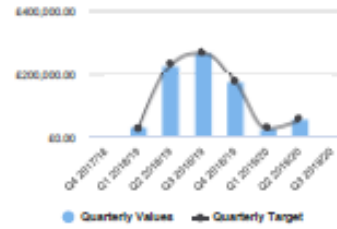
