The next Cabinet meeting following the one scheduled for 26th September does not occur until 17th October and delaying this recommendation will result in a significant delay and impact to the business plan and scheduled re-opening of the Tamworth Assembly Rooms. The project itself is widely publicised and has been in the public domain for a considerable period of time.
