Who will be affected and how? A decent and affordable home is a fundamental factor in securing employment, economic well-being and good health. The aims of the housing strategy are to ensure that everyone who lives and works in Tamworth has access to appropriate housing to achieve this. Every household in Tamworth could be affected, but the most impact will be on those who live in properties which are in a poor state of repair, or whose housing is insecure. Increasing the supply of new homes will reduce the pressure on overcrowded households, and help ensure that older people have access to housing which is tailored to their needs
