The wider determinant of health indicators provided by Public Health England are broken down into the following areas

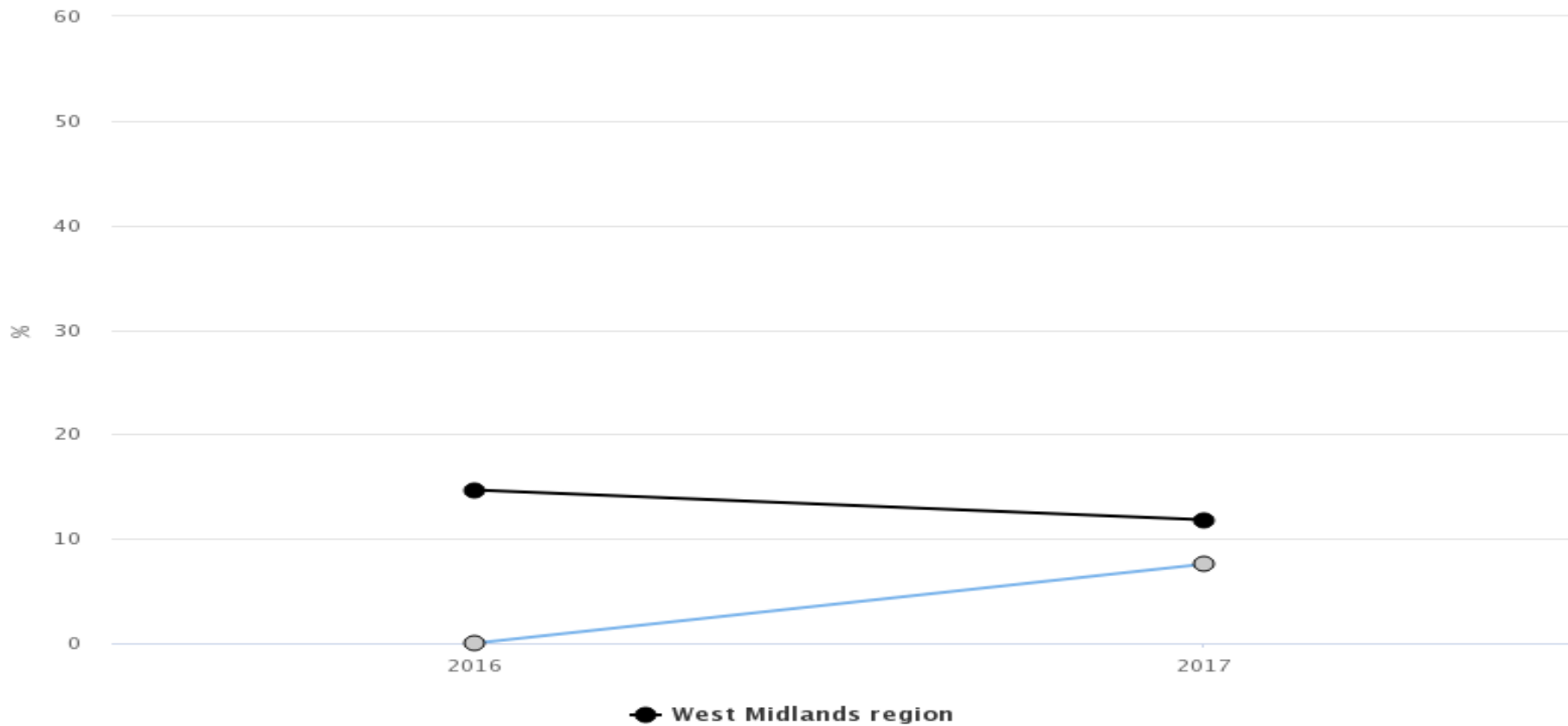
- **Natural and built environment,**

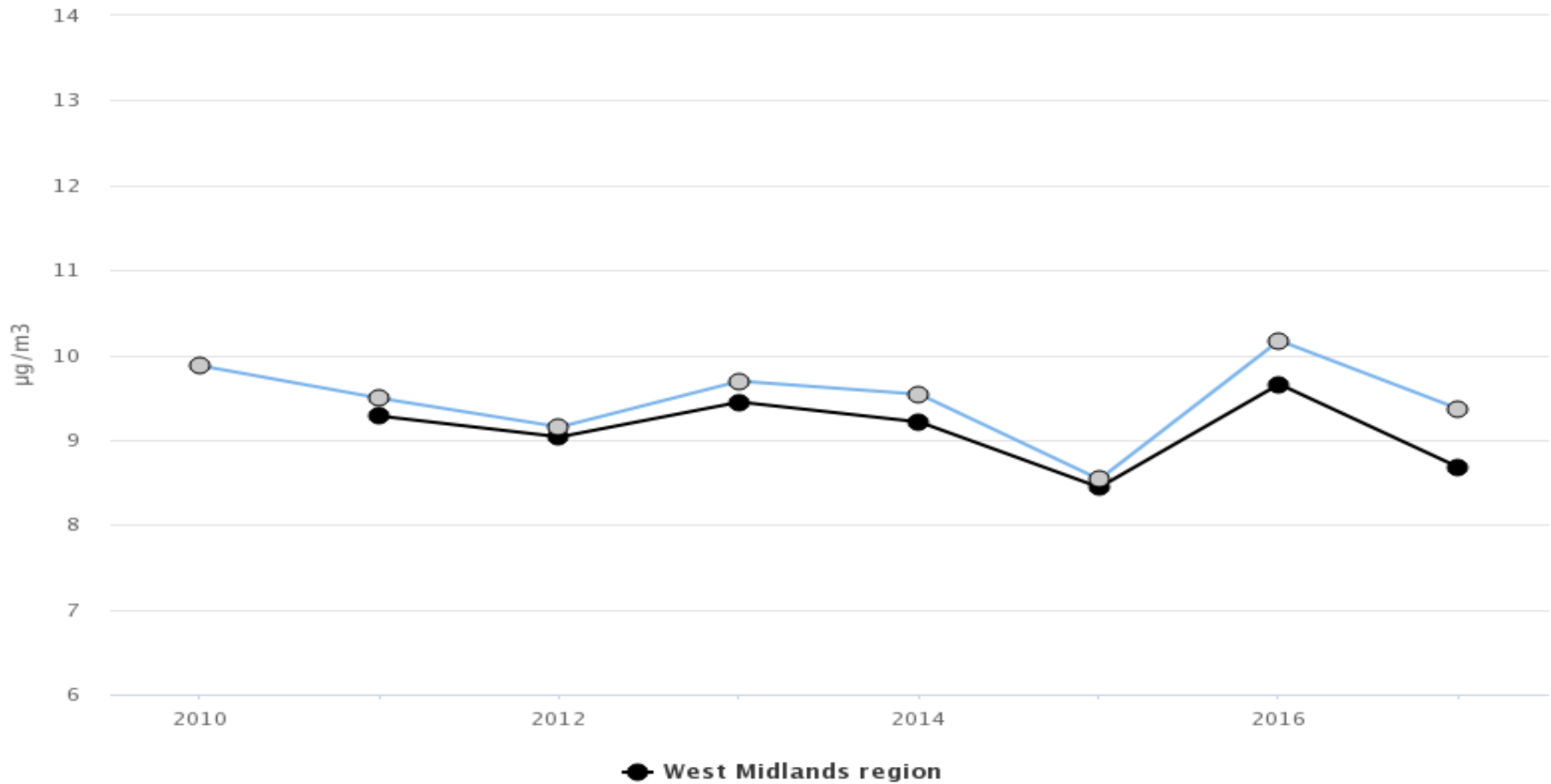
Access to Healthy Assets & Hazards Index for Tamworth

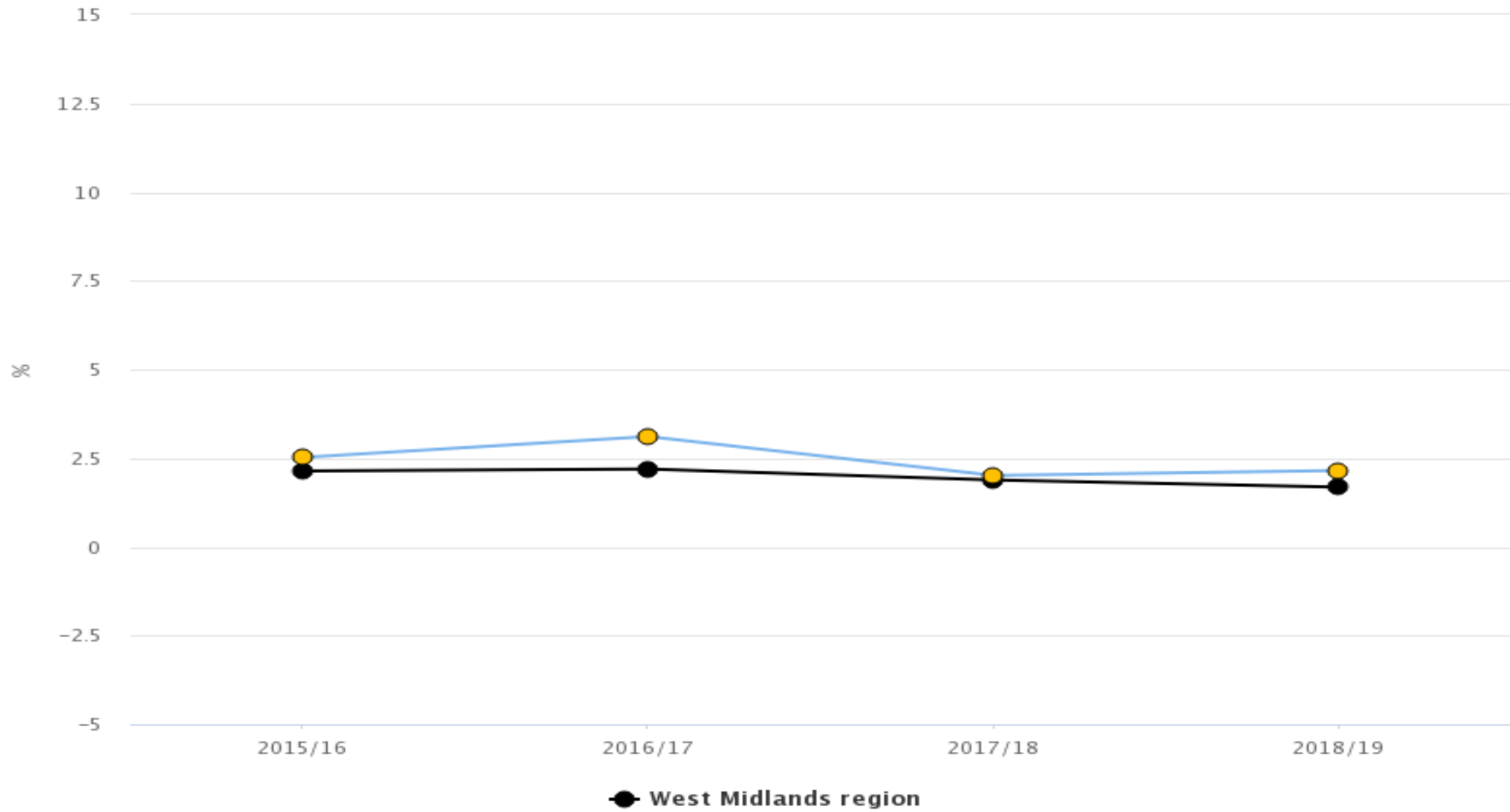
Air pollution: fine particulate matter for Tamworth

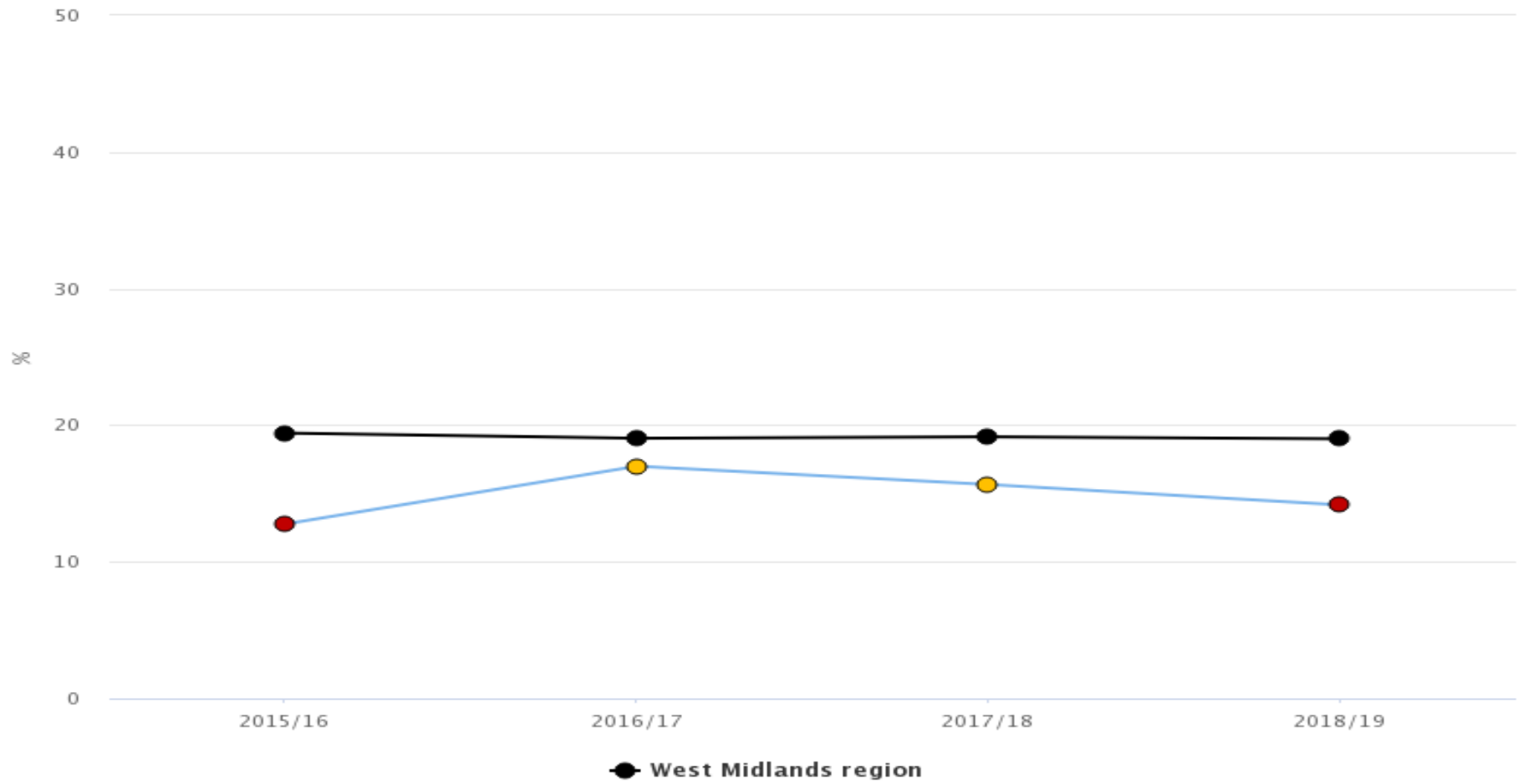
Percentage of adults cycling for travel at least three days per week for Tamworth

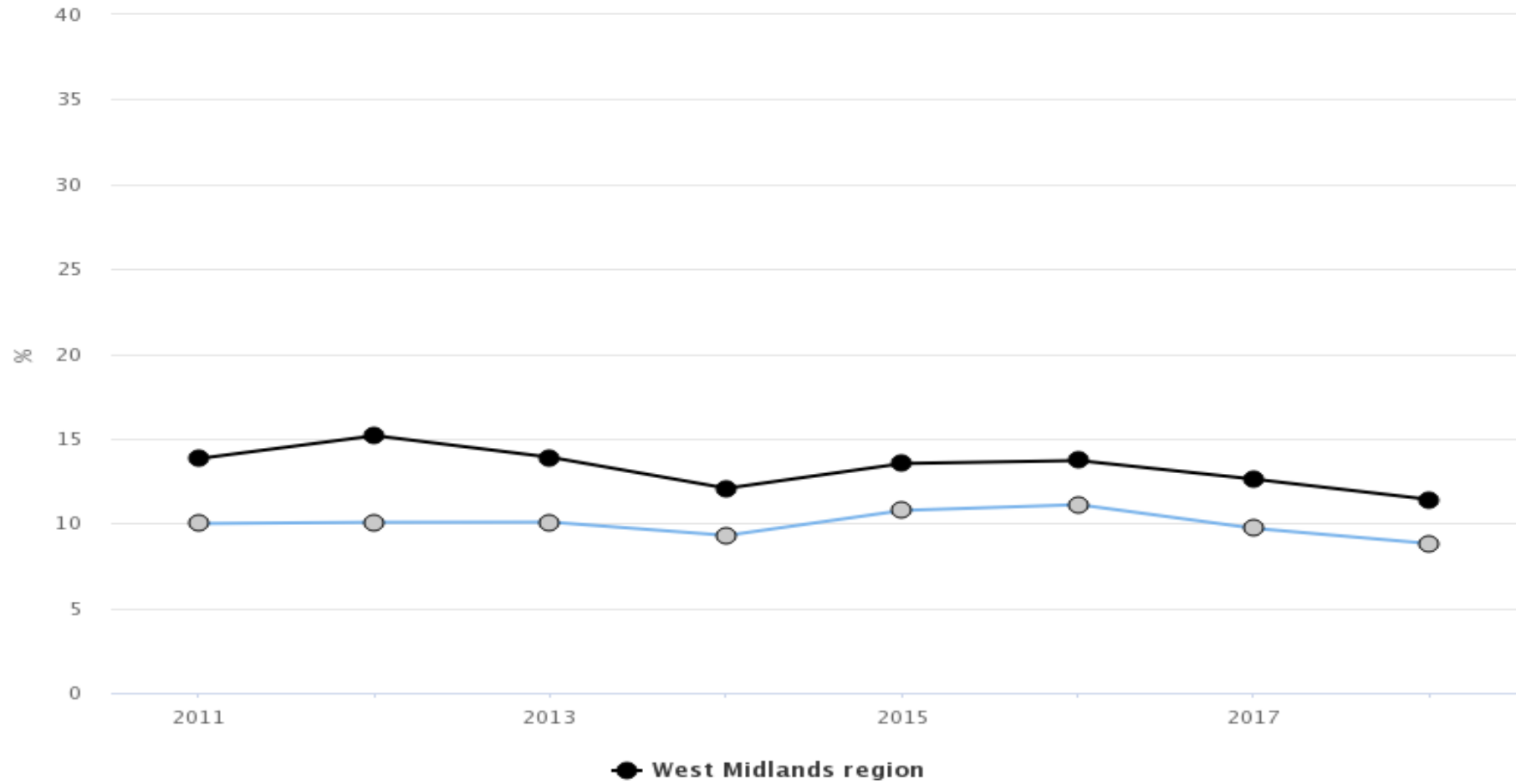
Percentage of adults walking for travel at least three days per week for Tamworth

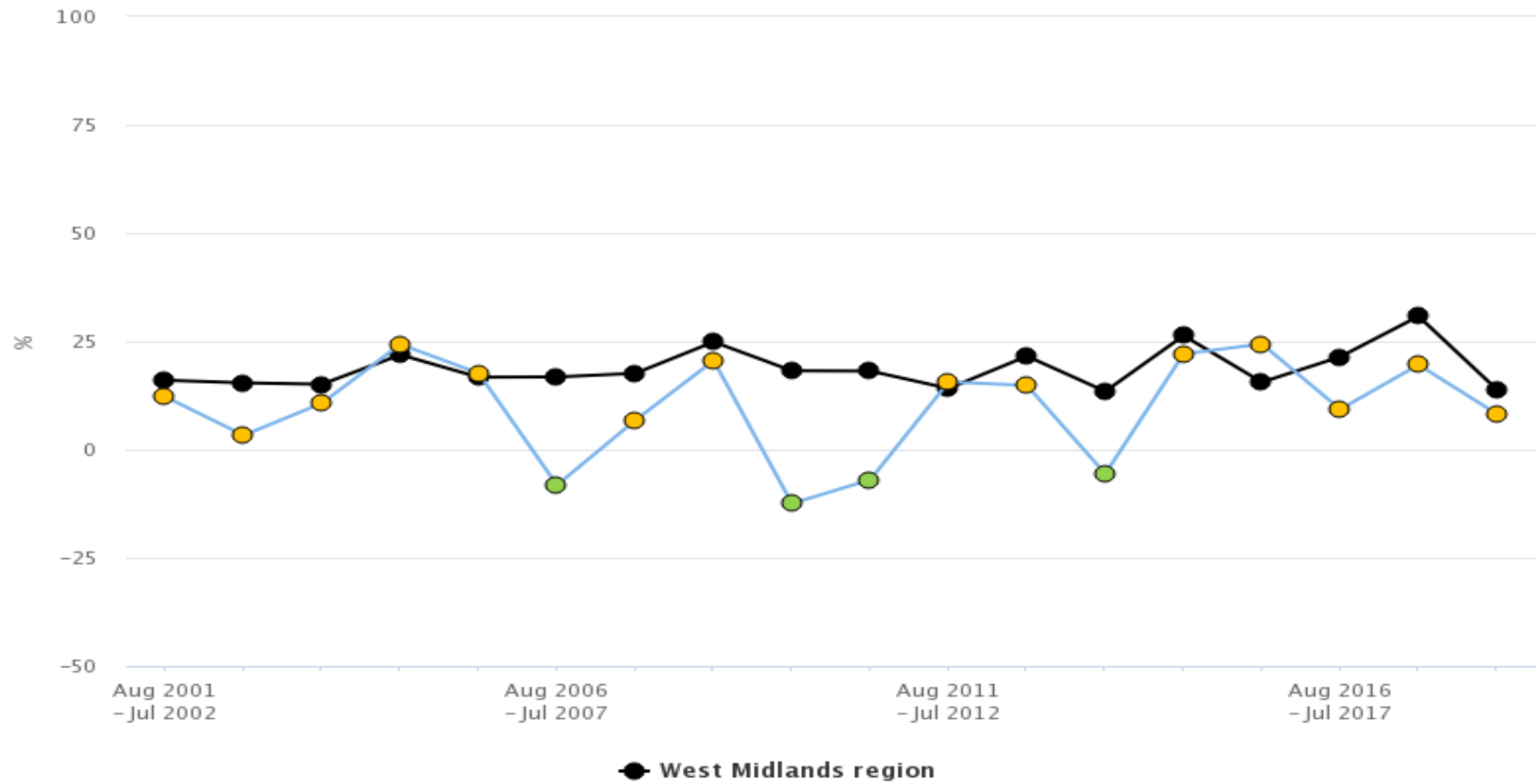
Fuel poverty for Tamworth

Excess winter deaths index for Tamworth

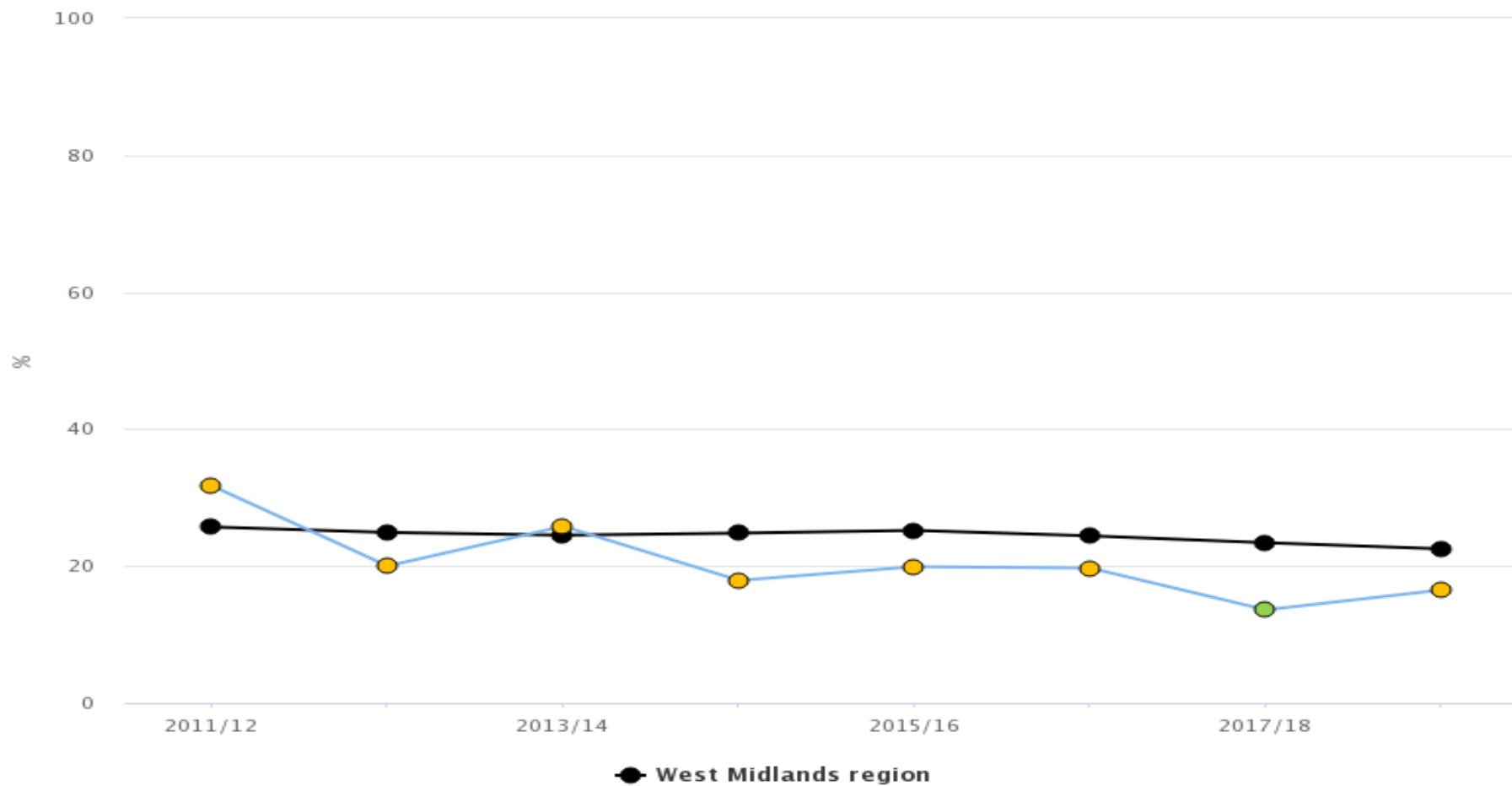

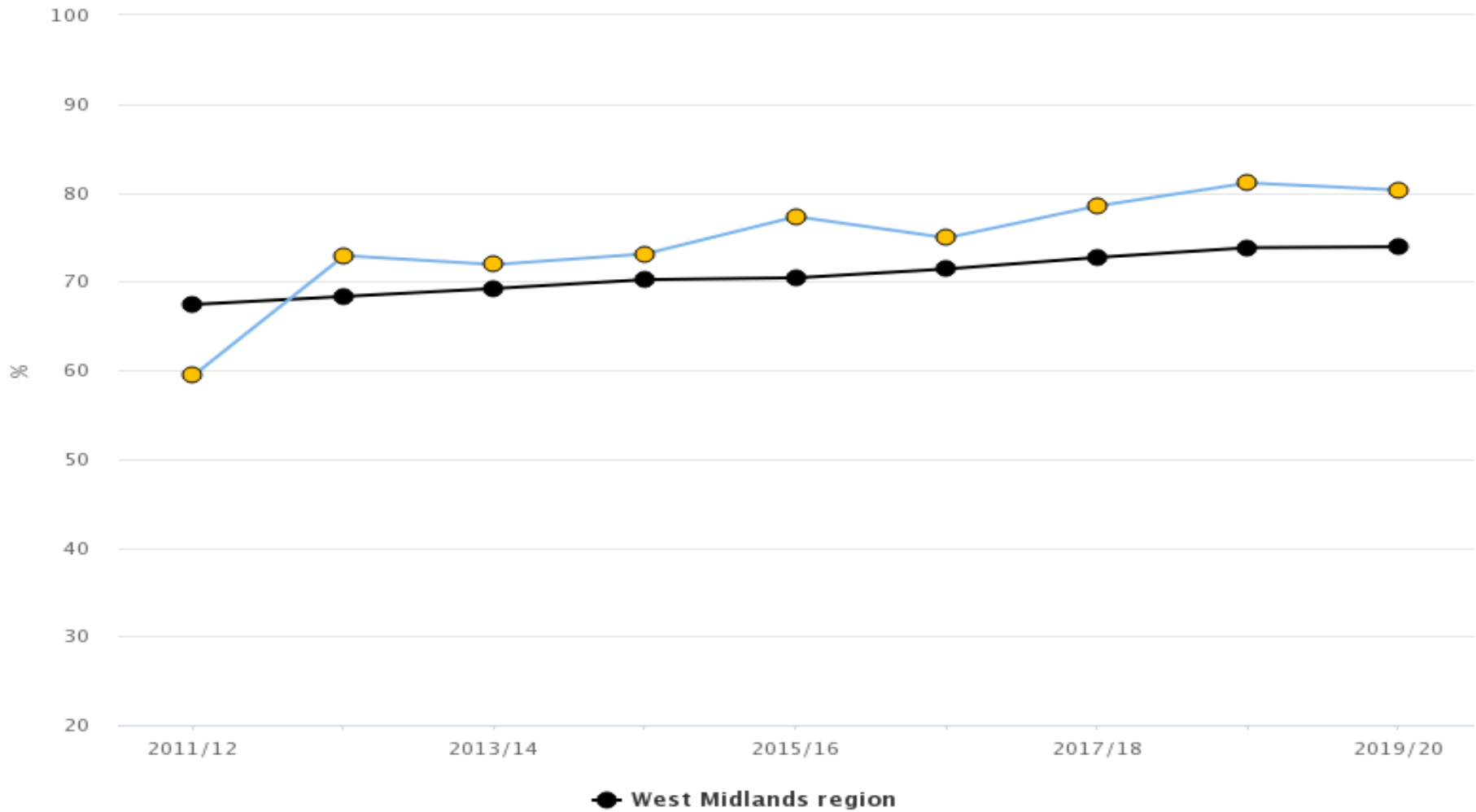
Economic inactivity rate for Tamworth

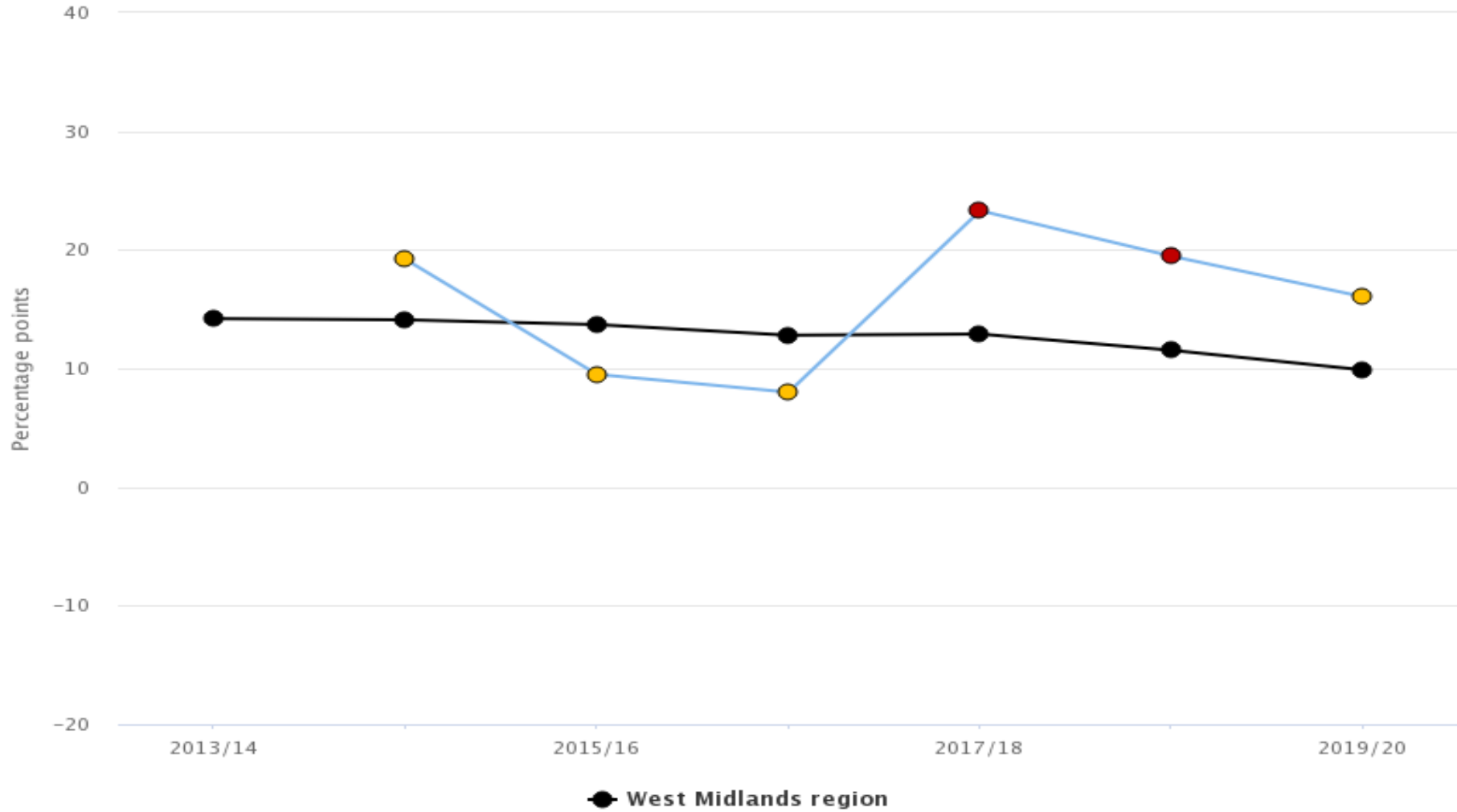

Gap in the employment rate between those with a long-term health condition and the overall employment rate for Tamworth

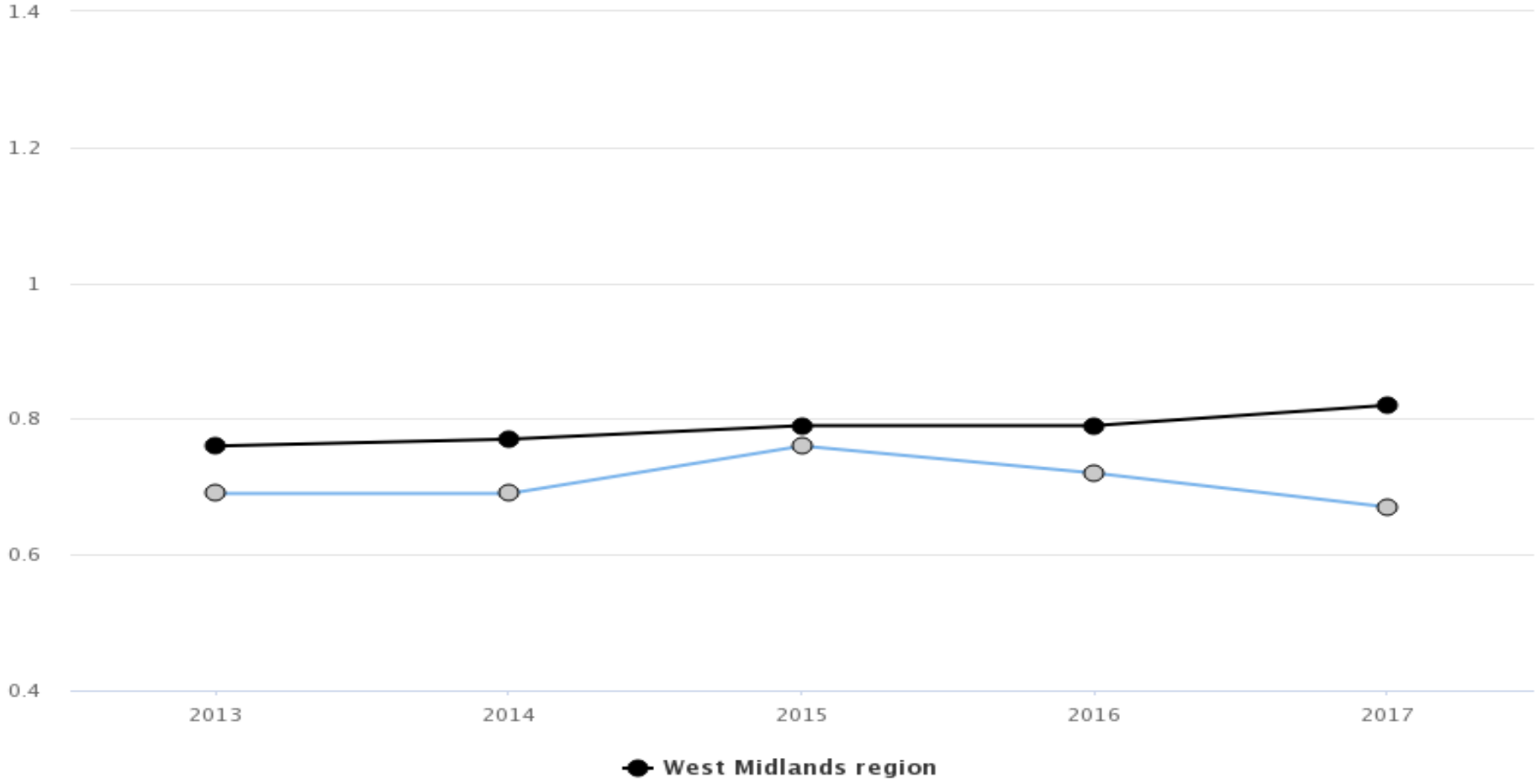

Job density for Tamworth

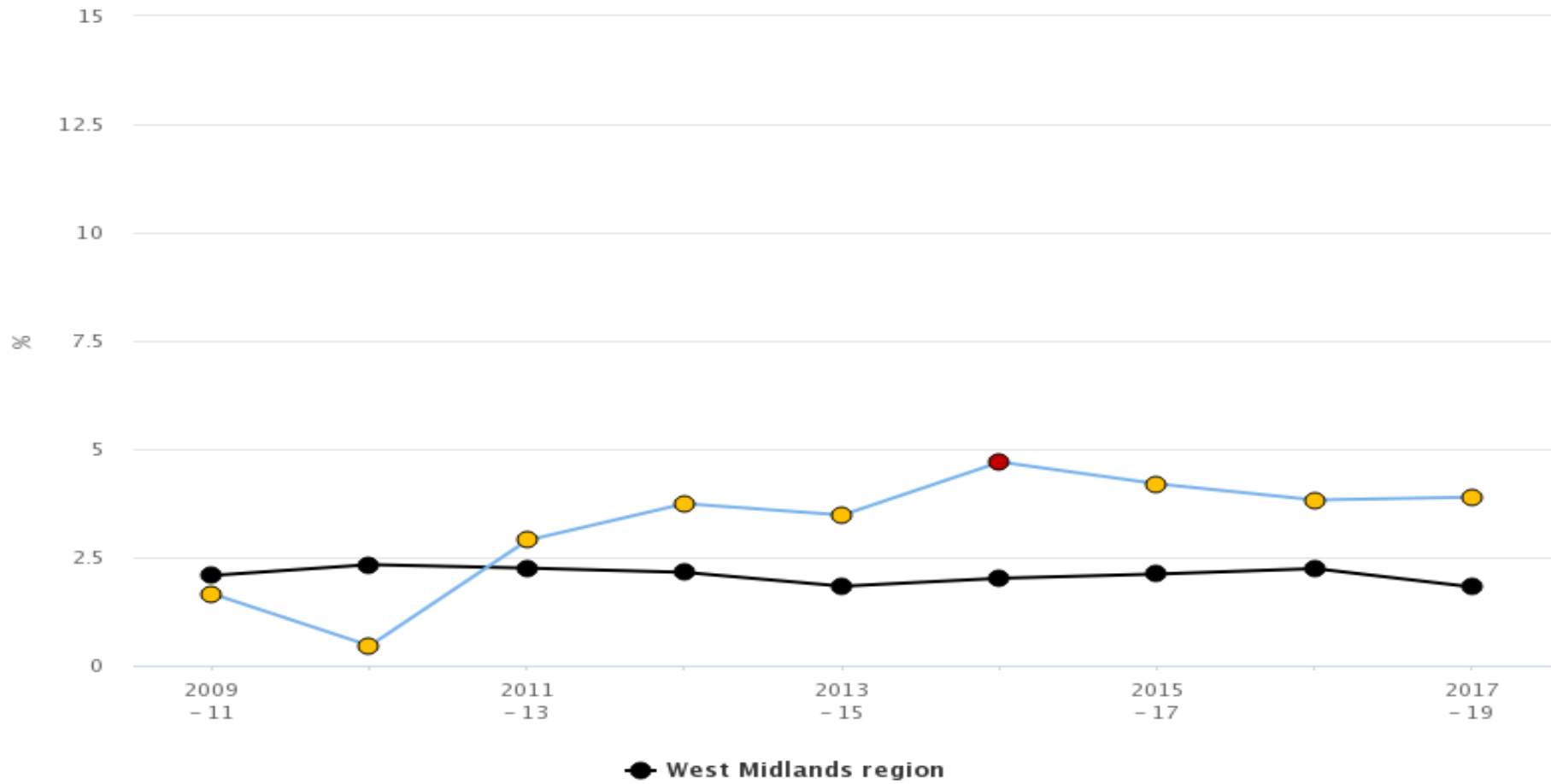

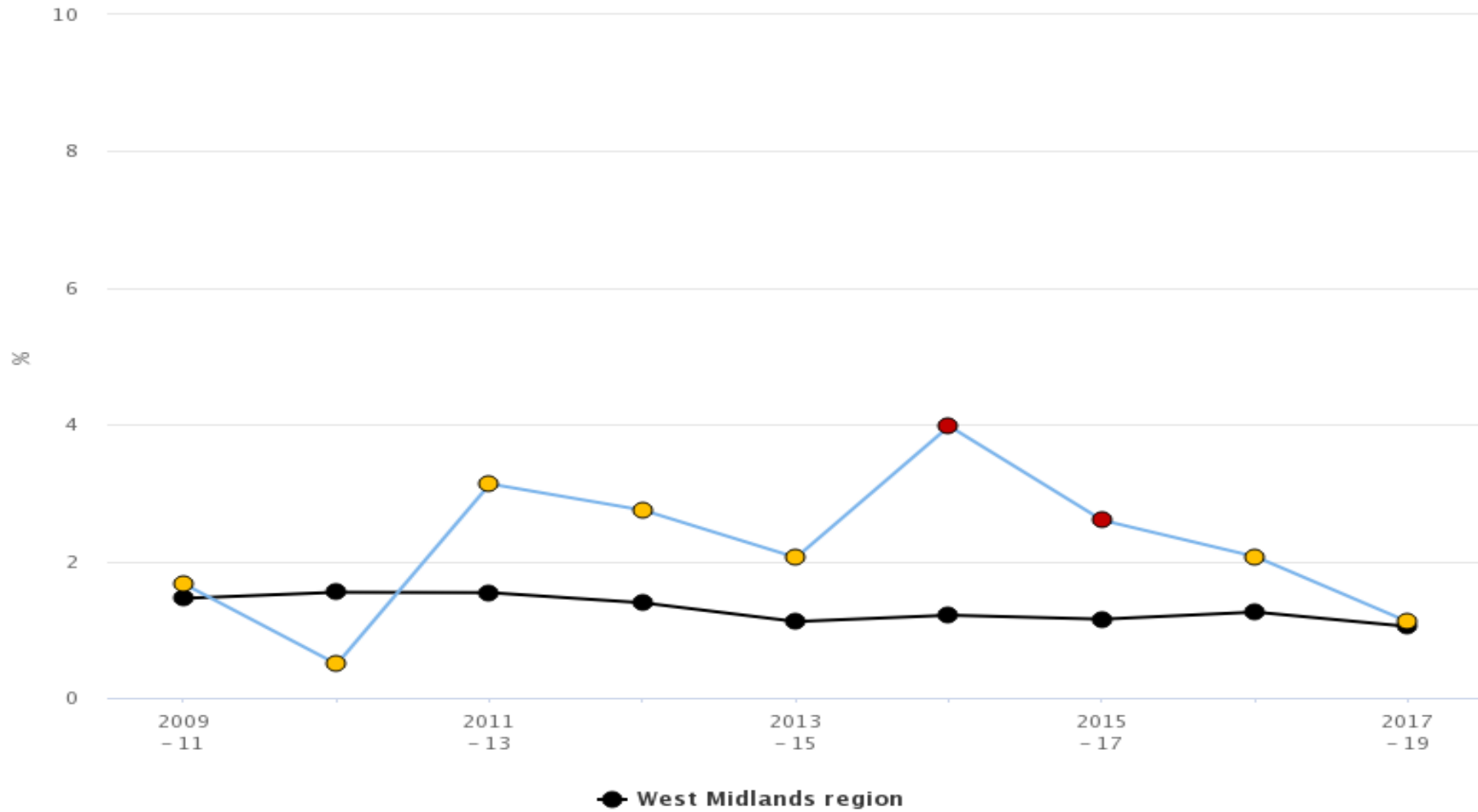
Sickness absence - the percentage of employees who had at least one day off in the previous week for Tamworth

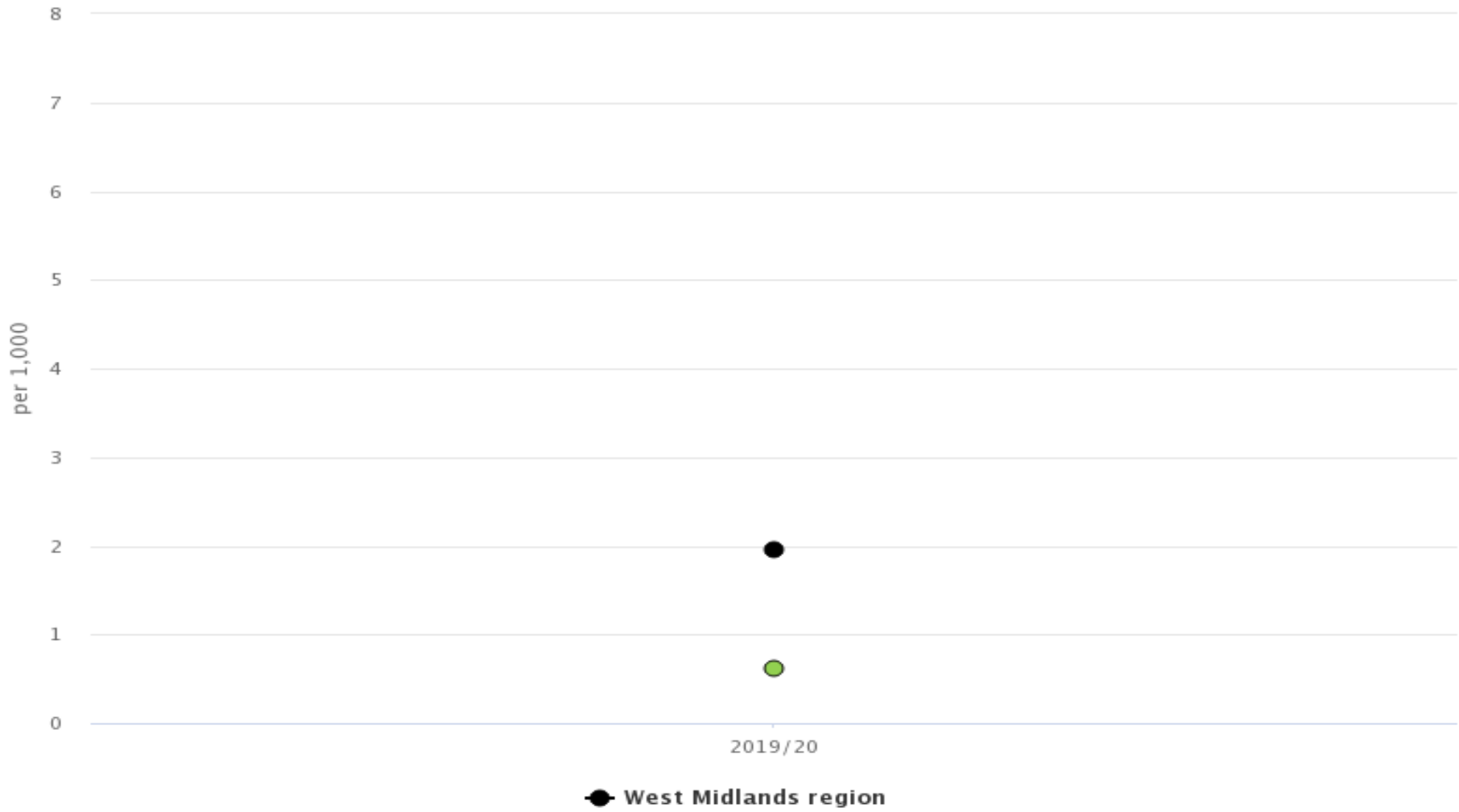
Homelessness - households owed a duty under the Homelessness Reduction Act (main applicant 55+ yrs) for Tamwoi

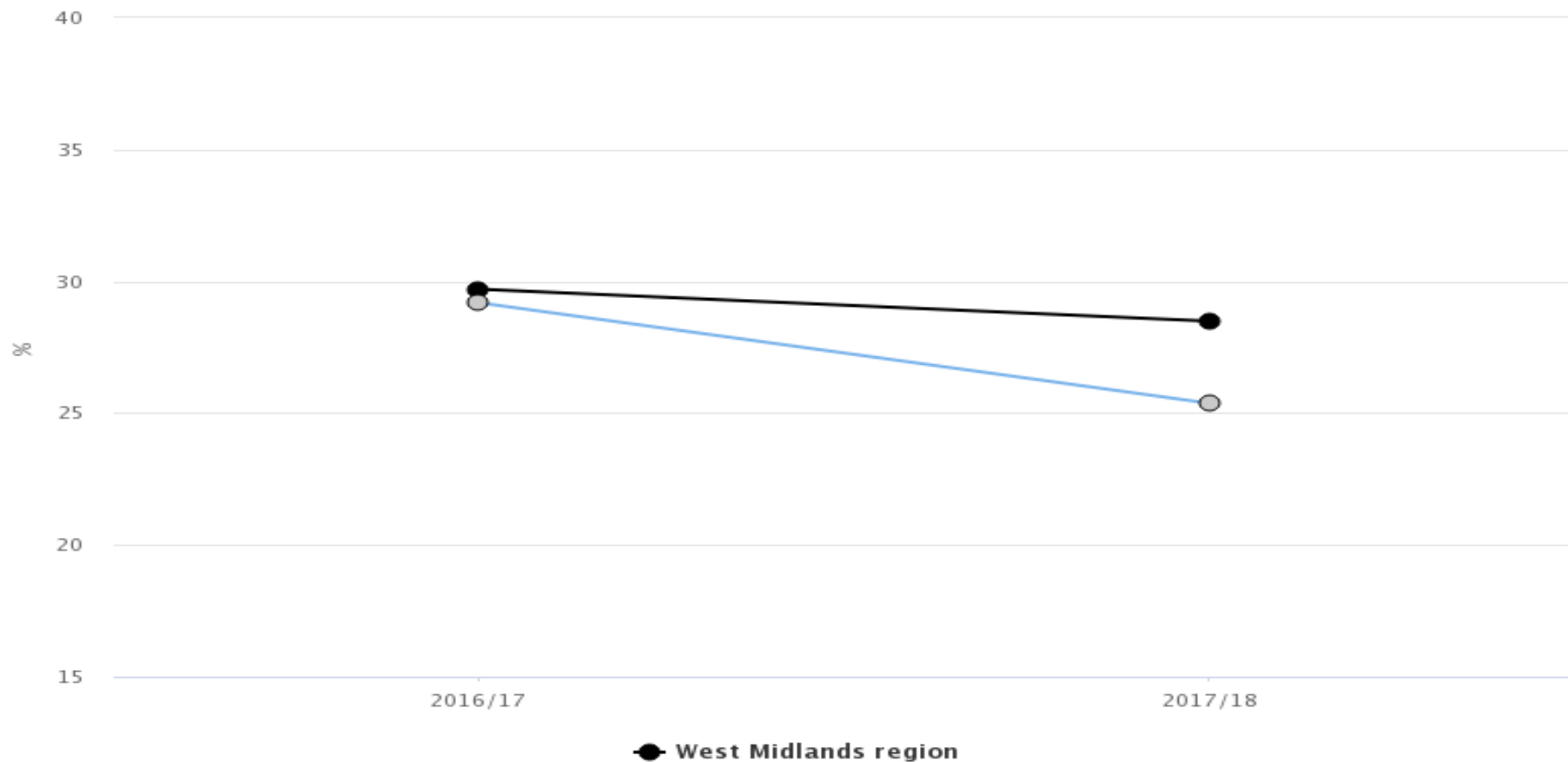
Homelessness - households in temporary accommodation for Tamworth

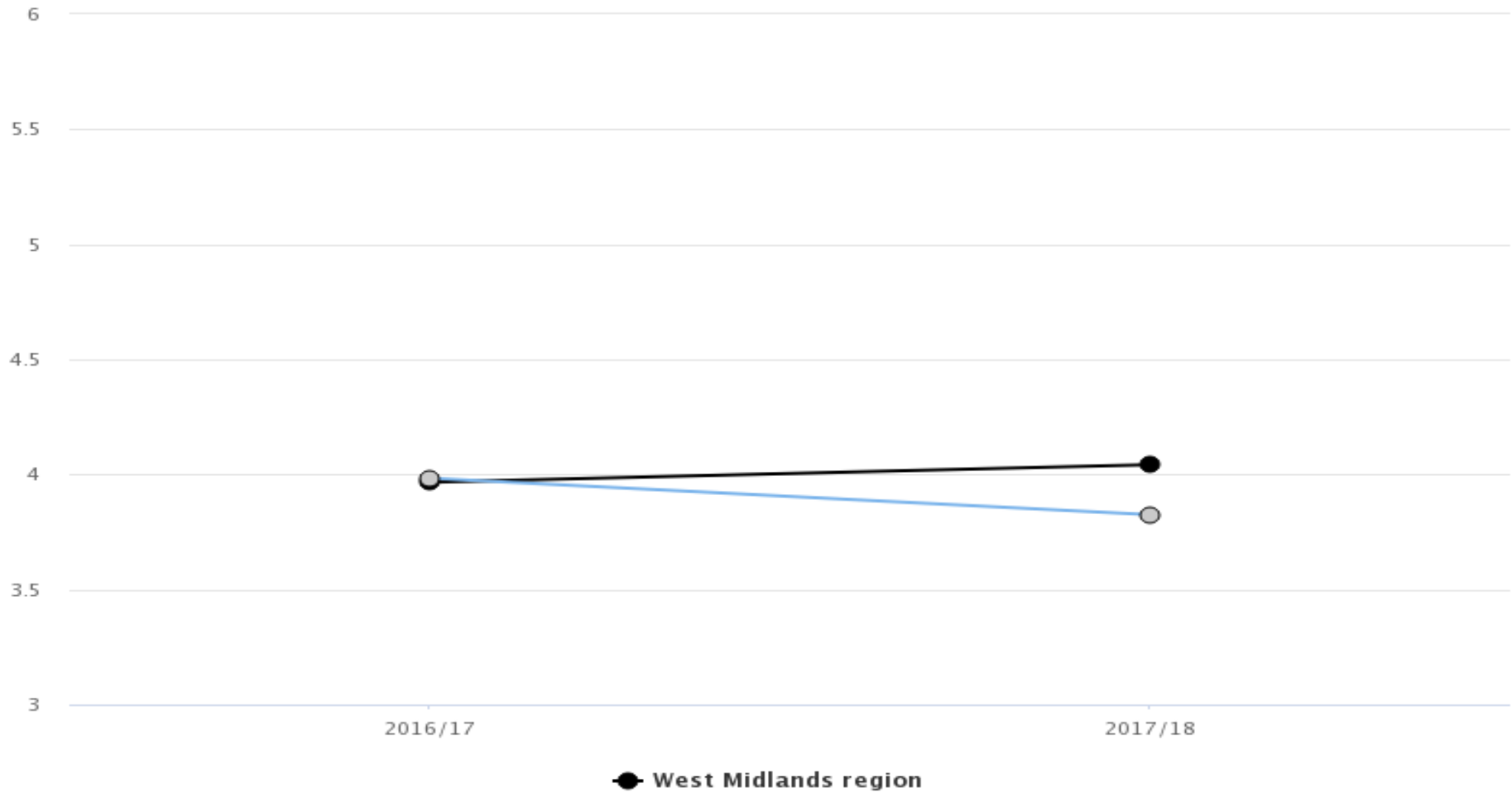
Re-offending levels - percentage of offenders who re-offend for Tamworth

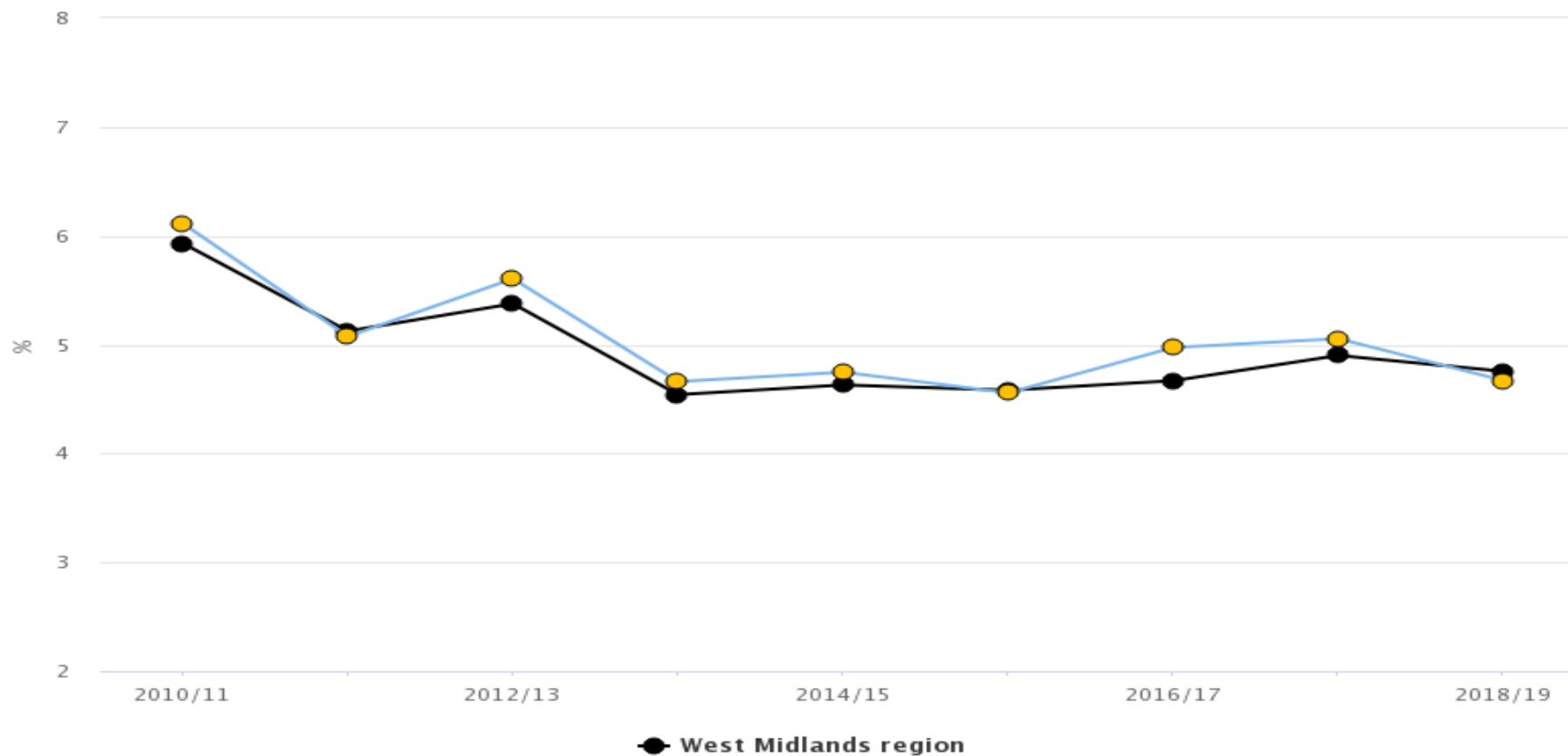
Re-offending levels - average number of re-offences per re-offender for Tamworth

Pupil absence for Tamworth

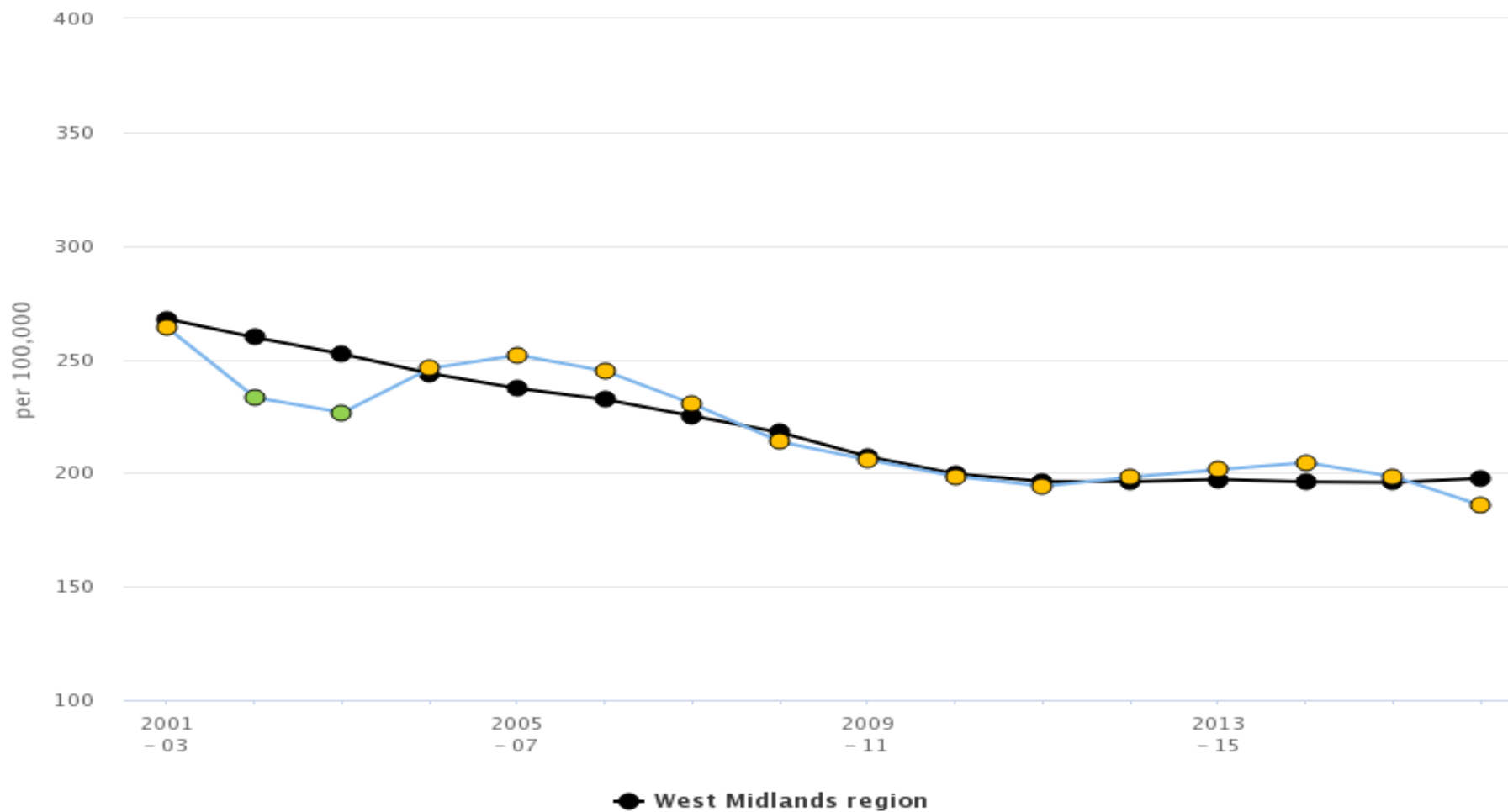

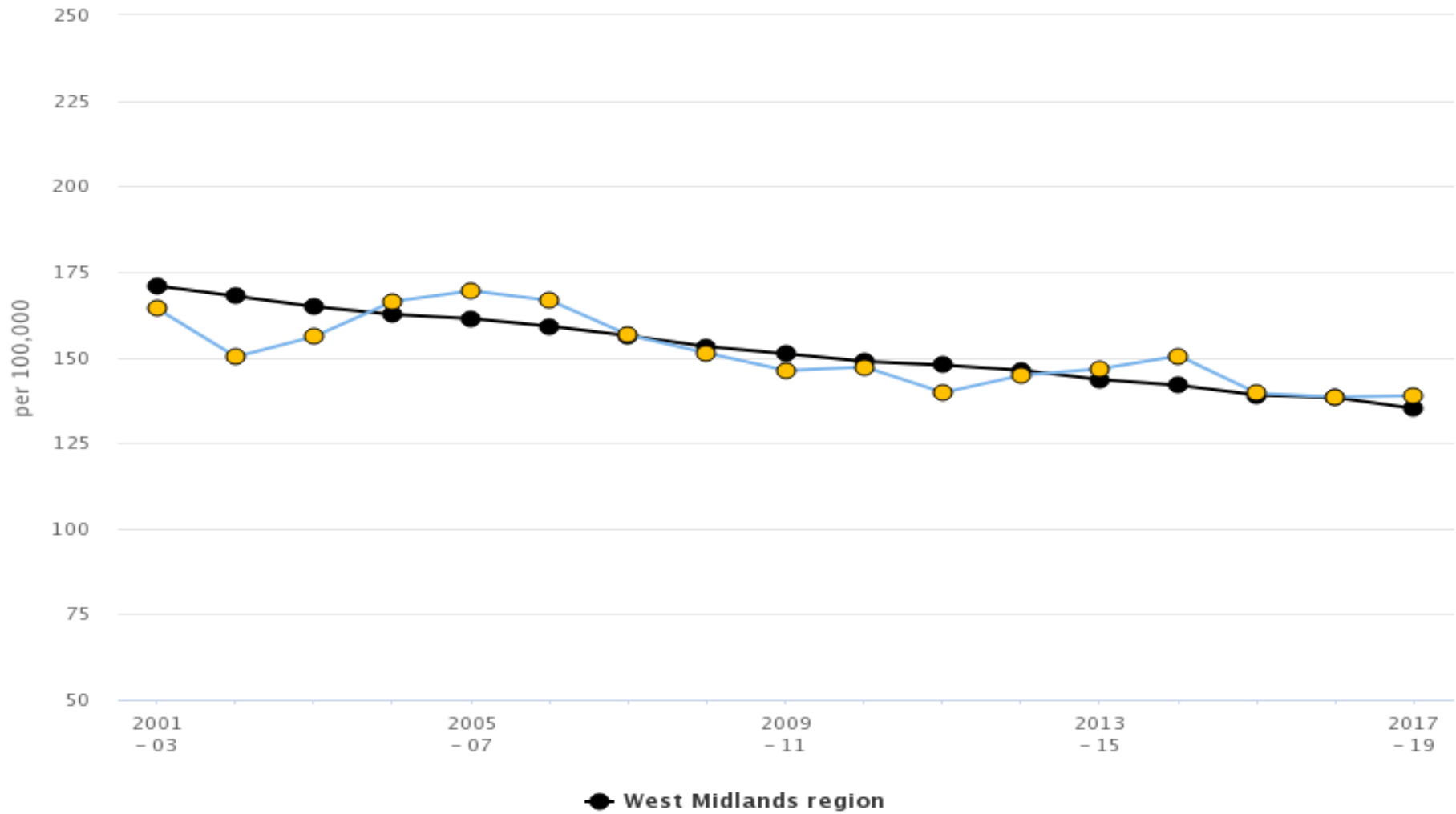

Mortality rate from causes considered preventable (2016 definition) for Tamworth



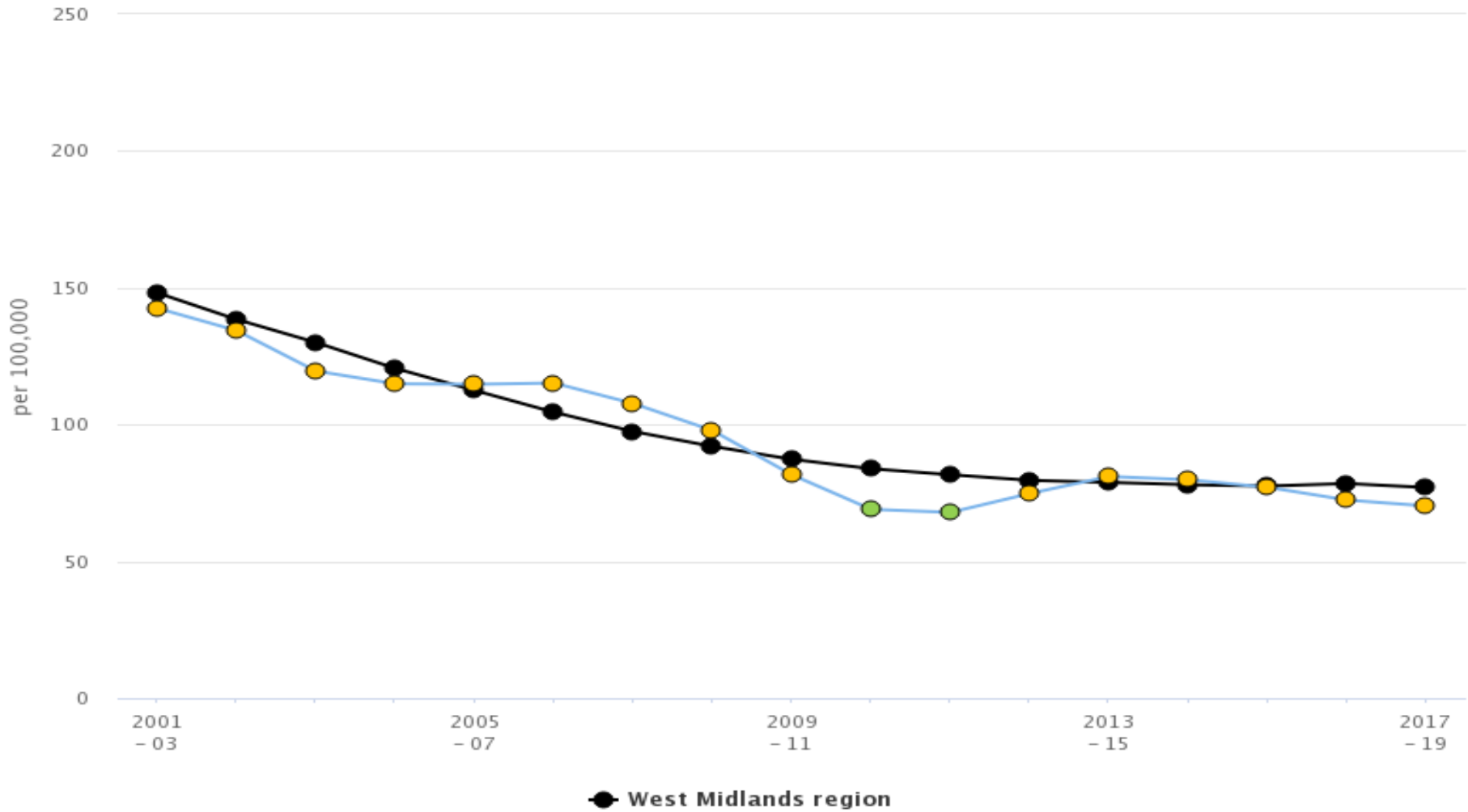

Under 75 mortality rate from cancer for Tamworth



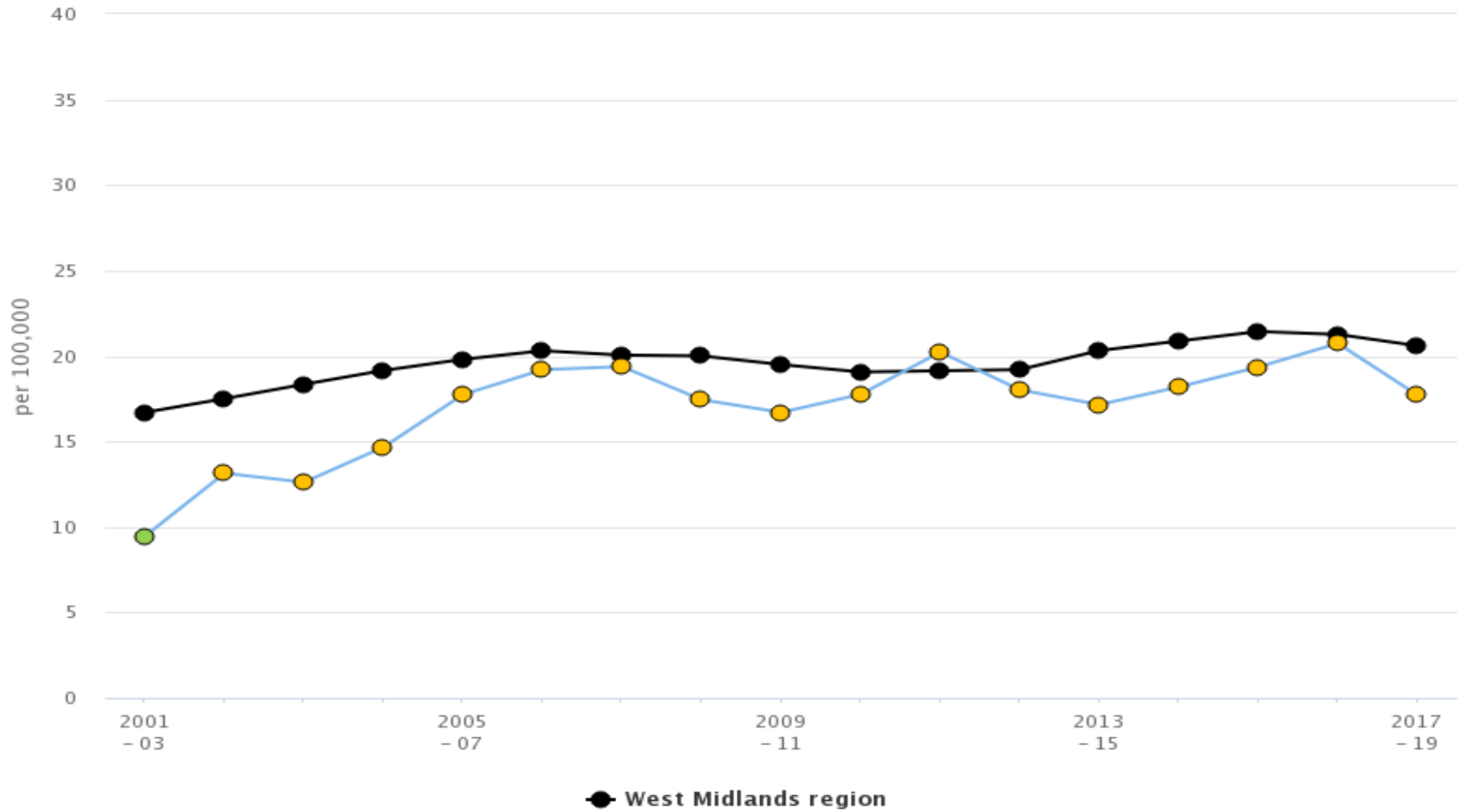

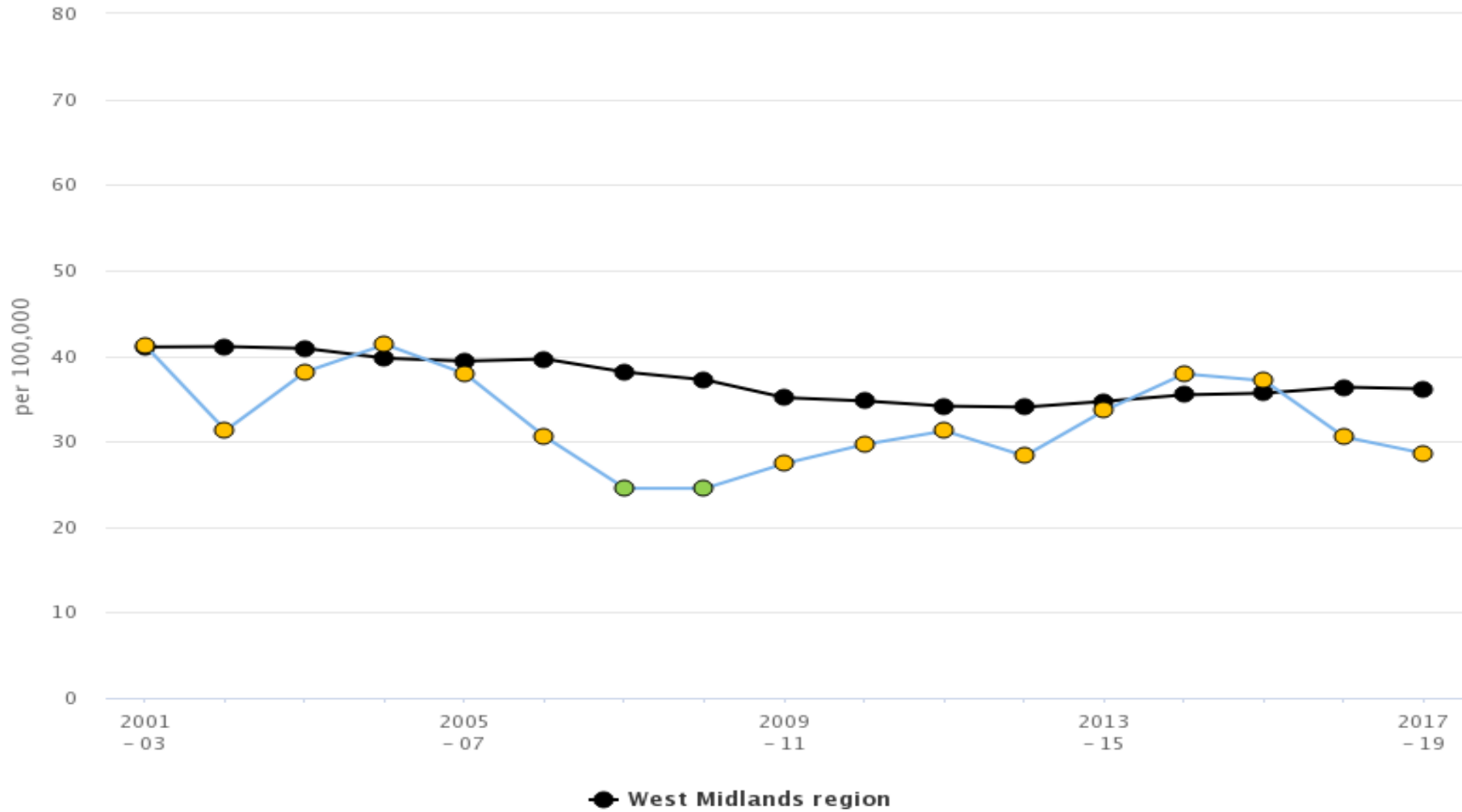
Under 75 mortality rate from liver disease for Tamworth
