

Alcohol and Late Night Refreshment Licensing 2021/22: data collection for period 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022

Introduction

The Home Office is asking all licensing authorities in England and Wales to complete this statistical return for 2021/22 to enable them to produce the Alcohol and Late Night Refreshment Licensing 2021/22 statistical release (you do not need to submit data for 2018/19, 2019/20 or 2020/21, this collection was not scheduled for 2018/19 and cancelled due to the pandemic for years 2019/20 and 2020/21). May we take the opportunity to remind you that Alcohol and Late Night Refreshment Licensing is on the **mandatory** single data list of datasets that local government must submit to central government.
