EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

At its meeting of the 31st October 2013, the Audit & Governance Committee endorsed the revised Counter Fraud and Corruption Policy Statement, Strategy and Guidance Notes (**Appendix 1**) and the revised Whistleblowing Policy (**Appendix 2**). Both Policies plan to be endorsed by the Appointments and Staffing Committee at its meeting on the 11th December 2013 and have been endorsed by the Trade Unions.

The main changes to the policies take into account the changes required under the Enterprise & Regulatory Reform Act 2013 which states that any disclosure made using the Whistleblowing Policy, within reasonable belief of the worker making the disclosure, will only be protected if it is made in the public interest.
